## INFORMATION FOR RUNNERS

Welcome to the 1984 Labatt's Lite Series of New Brunswick Road Racing! We have made some interesting changes this year that will improve the series for competitive and recreational runners alike.

There are 25 races from which you may earn series points. Ten of these are grouped into a "Super Series". Races in the Labatt's Lite Super Series will be special in three ways:

- 1) There will be more points awarded - twice as many for some runners.
- 2) Only Labatt's Lite Super Series points will be used to calculate Provincial standings.
- 3) Labatt's Lite Super Series points will be required to earn the higher series awards.

AWARDS — The most significant change is that all runners will now be able to earn one of five awards. These awards are in the form of quality crests (see cover design) in five colors. Points from any of the 25 races may be tabulated toward the Green, Red and White crests while Labatt's Lite Super Series points must be used when calculating totals for the Silver Award. Blue crests will be given to the top runners in the Provincial Standings. Runners may claim only one crest — the highest one earned based on the following standards:

**GREEN AWARD** - 5 points in at least 3 races.

**RED AWARD** - 25 Points in at least 3 races and two zones.\*

**WHITE AWARD** - 75 Points in at least 5 races and 2 zones.\*

**SILVER AWARD** - 30 points from Labatt's Lite Super Series.

**BLUE AWARD** - Top 20 Males  
Top 10 Females In  
Top 10 Masters Provincial  
Top 5 Veterans Standings \*\*

**\*ZONES** - The province has been divided into 4 zones - North, South, East and West. Event details in this booklet will indicate the zone for each race.

**\*\*PROVINCIAL STANDINGS** - These will be calculated using the results of Labatt's Lite Super Series Races only. In order to be listed an athlete must:

- a) be a New Brunswick resident.
- b) Compete in at least one Provincial Championship (10km - June 24, Newcastle/ 20 km - August 12, Riverview).

**NOTE:** for Crest Awards and Provincial Standings, end of series points will be tabulated from up to 8 races. If 9 or more races are run, points will be calculated using the best of 8 finishes.

**POINTS:** Points for open mens category will be calculated on overall finish position in races. Points for females, masters and veterans will be calculated based on finish position within their own category.

TIES (Provincial Standings) *When points are equal, the runner receiving the higher standing will be the one who had the best finish in his/her races. If the tie remains, the second best races will be considered. This will continue, as necessary, for the 3rd, 4th, etc. best races, until the tie is broken.*
