RULES AND REGULATIONS

 All finishers in Sunlife Championship Series races will receive points based on their finish position:

*Record breaking performances score 5 bonus points.

- 2. End of series points for each participant will be tabulated from up to 8 races. If more than 8 races are run, points will be calculated using the best 8 finishes.
- 3. Provincial Champions will be declared for Open, Women and Masters (40 years and older) categories.
- 4. All participants who meet the following qualifications will receive a provincial ranking and a Sunlife Championship Series souvenir:
 - (a) Must be a New Brunswick resident;
 - (b) Must complete at least 3 Sunlife Championship Series events;
 - (c) Must have 5 or more points.
- 5. Ties will be broken for top 10 positions only. When points are equal, the runner receiving the higher standing will be the one who has the best finish in his/her races. If the tie remains, the second best races will be considered. This will continue, as necessary, for the 3rd, 4th, etc. best races, until the tie is broken.
- In multi-race events, only one race will count for points. In all cases for 1981, the Sunlife Series race is the longest one.
- Only one runner per category per race will receive record breaking points — even if 2 or more runners are under the old record.
