## RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. All finishers in the Labatt's Lite Championship Series Races will receive points based on their finish position.

1st	30 pt.	13th	11 pt.
2nd	25 pt.	14th	10 pt.
3rd	22 pt.	15th	9 pt.
4th	20 pt.	16th	8 pt.
5th	19 pt.	17th	7 pt.
6th	18 pt.	18th	6 pt.
7th	17 pt.	19th	5 pt.
8th	16 pt.	20th	4 pt.
9th	15 pt.	21st	3 pt.
10th	14 pt.	22nd	2 pt.
11th	13 pt.	23rd	1 pt.
12th	12 pt.	24th	1 pt.

\*All finishers will receive 1 point.

\*Record breaking performances will score 5 bonus points.

2. End of series points for each participant will be tabulated from up to 8 races. If more than 8 races are run, points will be calculated using the best 8 finishes.
3. Provincial Champions will be declared Open, Women and Masters (40 to 50 years), Senior (50 years and older) Categories.
4. All participants who meet the following qualifications will receive provincial ranking.
  - (a) Must be a New Brunswick resident.
  - (b) Must complete at least 3 Labatt's Lite Championship Series events.
  - (c) Must have 5 or more points.
5. Ties will be broken for top 10 positions only. When points are equal, the runner receiving the higher standing will be the one who has the best finish in his/her races. If the tie remains, the second best races will be considered. This will continue, as necessary, for the 3rd, 4th, etc. best races, until the tie is broken.
6. In multi-race events, only one race will count for points in all cases in 1983.
7. Only one runner per category per race will receive record breaking points - even if two or more runners are under the old record.
